

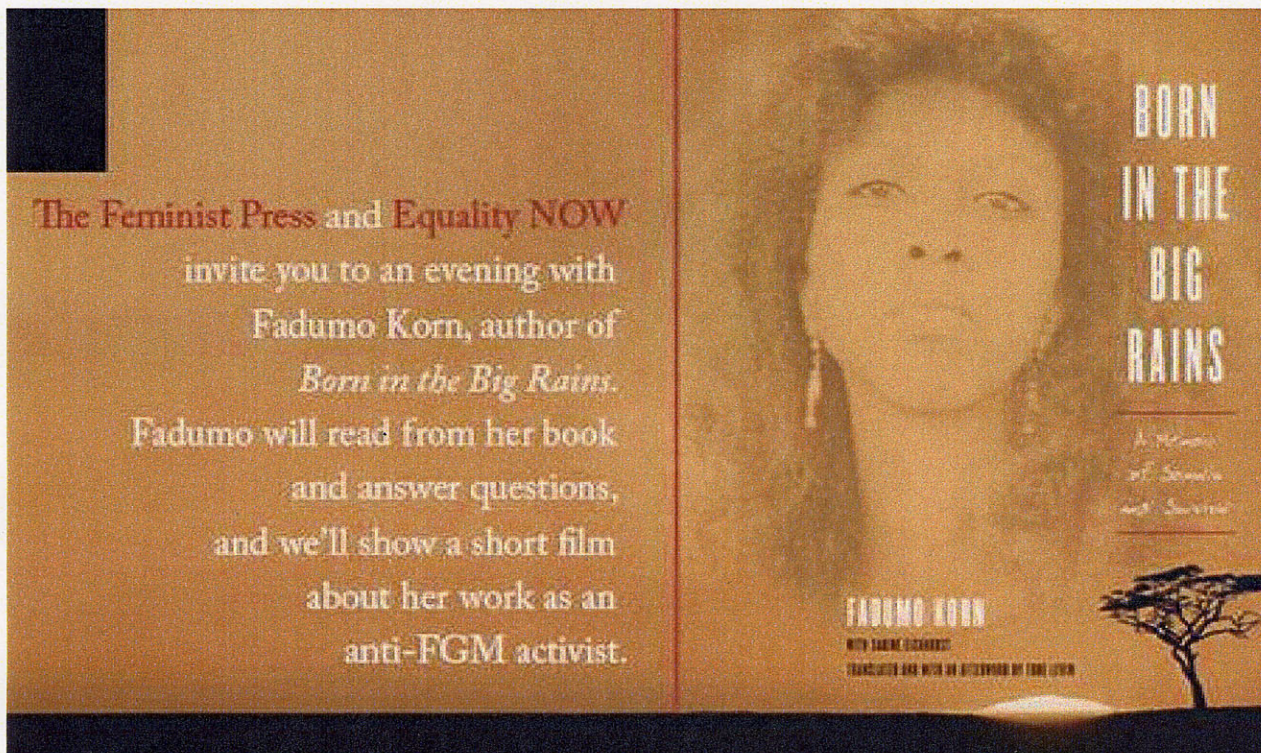

Born in the Big Rains tells Fadumo's story of the life-altering effects of female genital mutilation. It recounts her journey from life as a nomad on the Somali steppes to that of an activist in Germany dedicated to ending genital cutting. The book has received starred reviews in the U.S. and Germany.
